### Athletics

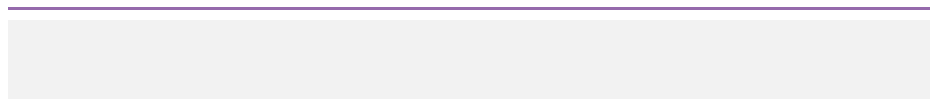
